Attention: Before you begin, be certain the firearm is clear and safe.

Step 1: Tap out these 2 pins to remove the trigger assembly.



Step 2: Push the hammer down into the "cocked" position.



Step 3: Pinch and remove the stock sear spring with your fingers.



Step 4: Insert the M-CARBO sear spring with your fingers.



Step 5: Re-insert the trigger assembly back into your Shotgun.



After you have reassembled your Remington 870 make sure you do a function check. Cycle the action and load a snap cap or spent shell casing into the chamber. With the rifle safety on "safe" and the barrel pointed in a safe direction, verify that the rifle will not fire when you attempt to pull the trigger. Place the safety now on "fire" and now verify the hammer falls.
